In addition to crisis response and 24-hour suicide prevention services, we host the Sexual Assault Counseling Center, Gallatin County Child Advocacy Center, and Hearts & Homes Family Resource Center, and Sacks Thrift Store. Through all the changes and growth within our organization and community, our core value remains the same: An effective, compassionate response to clients in crisis is critical to the wellbeing of a community.
